Planning your visit:

Summer Camp Field Trip Programs are available Monday through Friday. Programs last 2 hours and groups can picnic either before or after their program. Programs are available June through August and also during winter and spring school breaks.

Admission fees:

Reservations are required. Cost is \$8.00 per camper. Summer camp groups who come multiple times and bring over 100 campers to Oatlands are discounted at \$5.00 per student. Leaders and camp counselors are free.

Payment is collected when you arrive at the Carriage House Gift Shop. Payment methods accepted: cash, MasterCard, Visa and Checks. Invoices are available upon request.

On-Site logistics:

Buses may park in the main gravel parking lot

Groups are greeted at the Carriage House

Larger groups will be divided up

Programs occur rain or shine

Food and drink are not permitted in the mansion

There is outdoor walking on different surfaces so campers should wear appropriate footwear

Picnic tables and grounds are available at no extra cost if you wish to bring lunch

However, Oatlands does not have a sheltered place for eating or a drinking fountain

A garbage can is located in the picnic area

Public restrooms are available in the Carriage House and in the Gardens

There is no public restroom in the mansion
